EXAM: MRI HEAD WITHOUT CONTRAST

INDICATION: Headache

COMPARISON: None

TECHNIQUE: Multiplanar, multisequence MR imaging of the head obtained.

IV Contrast: None

FINDINGS:

Midline Structures: The sella turcica and pituitary gland are normal. Craniovertebral alignment and cerebellar tonsils are normal.

Ventricles: Normal size and configuration for patient age.

Intracranial Hemorrhage: None.

Brain Parenchyma: Brain parenchyma is normal in signal. There is no diffusion restriction.

Intracranial Vasculature: Major intracranial vessels are grossly patent.

Orbits: Normal.

Bone Marrow: Bone marrow signal within normal limits.

Visualized Upper Cervical Spine: Normal.

Paranasal Sinuses and Mastoid Bones: No acute sinusitis or mastoiditis.
